Only online submissions through the congress website will be accepted. Each author will receive a password which will allow to edit the abstract and inscription. Please save the password given. A new one can be requested from the log-in page.

You can edit your abstract until September 13, 2020 using the password given.

It's mandatory to give an email when submitting an abstract. All information regarding the abstract, such as: acceptance/rejection, date and session of presentation, and guidelines for presentation will be sent to that email.

The following topic categories are available:

- Basic
- Clinical
- Case Reports

The following form of presentation are available:

- Oral Communication
- Poster

An international panel of reviewers will review all abstracts anonymously.

There is no limit to the number of abstracts you may submit

Notification of acceptance

The abstract submitter will be notified of the acceptance or rejection of the abstract on October 07, 2020. The abstract submitter will receive all the information regarding the abstract. The abstract submitter is responsible for informing all other co-authors of the status of the abstract.



## Rules for Abstract Submission

- The abstract should not exceed 400 words (Not included title and authors);
- The abstract title must not exceed 150 characters in length; this includes spaces.
- Figures and tables are permitted and have to be uploaded;
- Abstracts can only be submitted in English;
- Research work should be original and innovative. Work can be presented prior to other Meetings, but **MUST** include new information/data;
- Only online submissions through the congress website will be accepted. Click [Here](#).;
- Abstracts will be published as submitted by the submitter author. It is the author's responsibility to submit a correct abstract. Any errors in spelling, grammar or scientific fact in the abstract will be reproduced as typed by the author. Authors' list will be published exactly as submitted;
- Please ensure that all authors, particularly, the 1st author and presenting author are identified correctly;
- The following subdivisions of your abstract are **MANDATORY**: Title, Aim, Background & Methods, Results, Conclusions, References;
- The abstract must not contain identification of the authors or institutions in the text;
- The registration of the presenting author must be concluded until October 13<sup>th</sup>, 2020. After that date the abstracts will be withdrawn from the scientific program;
